U-GO HELPS ambitious and promising young women in low-income countries to pursue tertiary education by providing financial scholarships funded by individuals and corporations in high-income countries. The lowest income countries have the lowest rates of university attainment and those limited opportunities are more likely to benefit men than women

Women in low income countries lag far behind women in wealthy countries. Higher education is still a glass ceiling for so many.

Lack of education contributes to high rates of gender inequality and slows national economic advancement

# How we work

In order to make rapid progress, work initially with well-respected NGOs already on the ground in low-income countries. Robin Hood Strategy: Raise funding in high-income countries to deploy in low-income ones.

Identify ambitious and promising young women who qualify for university but can't afford it. Offer them a "year one" financial scholarship, with contingent renewal

A low-cost model means that a little bit of money can go a long way. Scholarships in U-Go countries average US\$800 per student per year. In 2023, layer in life skills courses and a U-Go employment network to connect students with internships and full-time jobs.
